

## Sixth Form Students' Dress Code

Sixth Form is a place of work, and we therefore require students to look clean and smart in order to enable them to be role models within school and to represent the school appropriately in the local and wider community. Although there is no uniform for Sixth Form students, we do expect them to adhere to the following dress code:

### The following will NOT be permitted:

- Unnatural or excessive hairstyles
- Slogan sweatshirts or T-shirts
- Any ripped clothing (by wear and tear or design)
- Shorts
- Jogging Bottoms
- Vest tops without shirt or cardigan
- Casual t-shirts

### Students must wear:

- Skirt or dress of reasonable length
- Leggings may only be worn under a skirt or dress
- Full length trousers
- Smart jeans are permitted
- Shoes are preferred
- Smart, dark coloured trainers may also be worn
- Collared shirt / modest, smart tops which cover shoulders
- Plain jumper, sweatshirt or cardigan
- A jacket may be worn
- A tie is optional with a collared shirt

Students who are in breach of these rules will be taken out of lessons and asked, if possible, to go home and change. Further sanctions will be enforced for persistent breaches of these rules.

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
