ENROLMENT DAY

Students need to be at school for **8:45am** on **Tuesday 18 July**. During the day students will have the opportunity to attend sessions within the departments they hope to join in September and will be given further information about life in the Sixth Form and our expectations for students.

The aims of the day are:

- To give students an opportunity to visit departments and experience a sample lesson in the subjects they are hoping to study. Bridging work will be set in all subjects and will need to be completed in the subjects confirmed and taken up in September.
- To give students an opportunity to discuss subject choices and any changes with members of staff. This will be the last opportunity to discuss choices before September. Only those students who need to change options following exam results will be able to make changes after Enrolment day. Timetables will be produced using the subject choices confirmed in July for most students.
- To find out more about life in the Sixth Form and the opportunities that will be available to students.
- To meet students from other schools who will be joining us in September.
- To collect paperwork which needs to be completed and returned on Registration Day in September.
- To give students an opportunity to indicate two other students with whom they would like to be in a form group, if they have a preference.

Lunch will be available, with a cash till for students new to the school. The day will finish at 3:20pm.
