

Minimum Entry Requirements for Sixth Form Courses 2018

Applied Science	Grade 5 at GCSE in two or more sciences and Grade 5 in both GCSE Mathematics and English Language
Art, Craft and Design	Grade 6 in GCSE Art and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
Biology	Grade 6 in Combined Science or GCSE Biology (<i>including</i> a Grade 6 score on the Biology papers 1 and 2 higher theory papers), and Grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
Business Studies	Grade B in GCSE Business Studies if studied, and Grade 5 in both GCSE Mathematics and English Language
Chemistry	Grade 6 in Combined Science or GCSE Chemistry (<i>including</i> a Grade 6 score on Chemistry papers 1 and 2 higher theory papers), and Grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics
Computer Science	Grade 6 in GCSE Computer Science if studied (Grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics if not); Grade 5 in GCSE Mathematics is a minimum requirement
Design and Technology	Grade B in GCSE Resistant Materials, Electronic Products or Design and Technology if studied (if not, Grade 6 in another practical, design-related subject is desirable) and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
Drama and Theatre Studies	Grade 6 in GCSE Performing Arts/Drama if studied (Grade 6 in GCSE English Literature if Drama was not taken) and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
Economics	Grade B in GCSE Business Studies if studied, Grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or Mathematics and Grade 5 in the other
English Language	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language and Grade 5 in GCSE English Literature
English Literature	Grade 6 at GCSE English Literature and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
French	Grade 6 in GCSE French and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
Geography	Grade 6 in GCSE Geography if studied (if not, Grade 6 in English Language or Literature), and Grade 5 in both GCSE English Language and Mathematics
German	Grade 6 in GCSE German and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
Health and Social Care	Grade B in GCSE Health and Social Care if studied, and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
History	Grade 6 in GCSE History if studied (if not, Grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature) and a minimum of Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
Mathematics	Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics is desirable; if a student achieves Grade 6, entry will be subject to passing an extra test set by school in September
Further Mathematics	Grade 8 in GCSE Mathematics is desirable; students with a strong Grade 7 may be considered. Students who take Further Mathematics must also take single Mathematics and two other subjects
Music	Grade 6 in GCSE Music (students without GCSE Music may be considered with an audition if they have achieved Grade 5 in a musical instrument/voice and Grade 5 Theory) and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
Physical Education	Grade 6 in GCSE PE if studied, Grade 5 in two GCSE Sciences and a Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
Physics	Grade 6 in Combined Science or Physics GCSE (<i>including</i> a Grade 6 score on the Physics papers 1 and 2 higher theory papers) and a Grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics
Psychology	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language and Grade 6 in two GCSE sciences; Grade 5 in GCSE Mathematics desirable – students with a strong Grade 4 may be considered
Religious Studies	Grade 6 in GCSE Religious Studies if studied (if not, Grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature) and Grade 5 in English Language
Spanish	Grade 6 in GCSE Spanish and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
