Since Covid-19, there have been lots of changes for many of us. We've had lots of concerns raised by young people, many of whom are anxious about their future, worried about what opportunities there are going to be and asking for advice on how they can get ready for future.

The event will run from 10am until 3pm and will cover a wide range of topics including:

- Coping with changes and keeping yourself positive.
