



Progress 8 (P8) is an indicator of how well a student has achieved, compared to students of similar ability nationally.

Since 2016 we saw four years of continuous and rapid improvement.

In 2019, Cockermouth School students achieved a P8 of 0.53. This means that on average, each student in over half of their GCSEs, achieved a whole grade higher than students of similar ability nationally.

This placed us in the top 10% of schools and is testimony to the continued hard work of our students and staff over the years.

No data is available for 2020 and 2021 as no public examinations took place.
